### MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

The Department of Marine Sciences, University of Puerto Rico at Mayagüez offers M.S. and Ph.D. degrees in Biological, Chemical, Physical and Geological Oceanography. Applications are invited for a tenure-track position as Assistant Professor in Chemical Oceanography, starting on July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017.

Ph.D. is required. Since Spanish and English are officially used at UPR, proficiency in both languages is highly recommended, but not required. The basic salary can be augmented through externally funded research projects.

We are especially interested in candidates with a demonstrated record of research and publication, excellent communication skills, and those that can take advantage of the Magueyes Island Marine Laboratory's excellent field access to nearby marine environments for the development of classes and research. Candidates will be considered within a wide spectrum of subjects including, but not exclusively, areas such as Carbonate Geochemistry, Biogeochemistry, Chemical Ecology, Natural Products Chemistry, or Marine Pollution. The candidate is expected to complement existing areas of expertise and develop collaborative research programs both within and outside the Department (see: [www.uprm.edu/cima](http://www.uprm.edu/cima)).

### JOB DESCRIPTION

The selected candidate is expected to develop an active extramurally funded research program, and to supervise Masters and Ph.D. students. Teaching requirements include an introductory graduate level course in Chemical Oceanography and additional graduate level courses in the candidate's area of specialty. In addition, the selected candidate is expected to publish original research in specialized journals and participate in departmental activities and committees as part of his regular tasks. The normal workload is 12 contact hours or the equivalency of 37.5 hours per week, according to University regulations, and it is divided in teaching and research tasks based on departmental requirements.
